Registration

Badge Collection Requirements

To check in and collect your event badge, you will be required to show a form of Government-issued photo ID and your registration QR Code.

- Forms of official Government-issued photo ID include passport, national ID card, or photo driving license (Employee or ID badges are not valid). A digital copy of your photo ID will also be accepted.
- Your registration QR code is available via the Cisco Events App. A copy will also be emailed to you shortly before the event.

Lost Badges

Lost badges can be reprinted on-site at a surcharge of €50+VAT.

Security

To ensure your safety and security during the event, security scanners have been installed at every entrance.

When you enter Cisco Live, you will enter via a security scanner. You may be subject to a search for anything that may pose a danger or cause disruption to the event.

You are not obliged to consent to such a search; however, a refusal may result in you being prevented from accessing the event. Any items found that are illegal in The Netherlands will be confiscated.

Please allow for this and arrive in good time for scheduled activities. To enable faster entry into the building, we suggest you leave any large luggage at your hotel.

- Following your badge collection, badge checks will be carried out. Please carry your Government-issued photo ID or digital copy and your event badge at all times.
- Please do not leave your personal property unattended. If you see anything that may be suspicious, notify a member of the security team or an event representative immediately.
